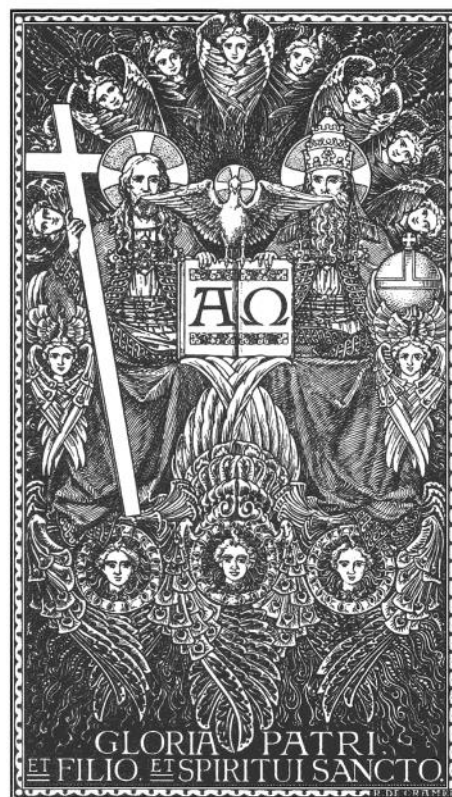
Dear Friends of St. Francis Church,
